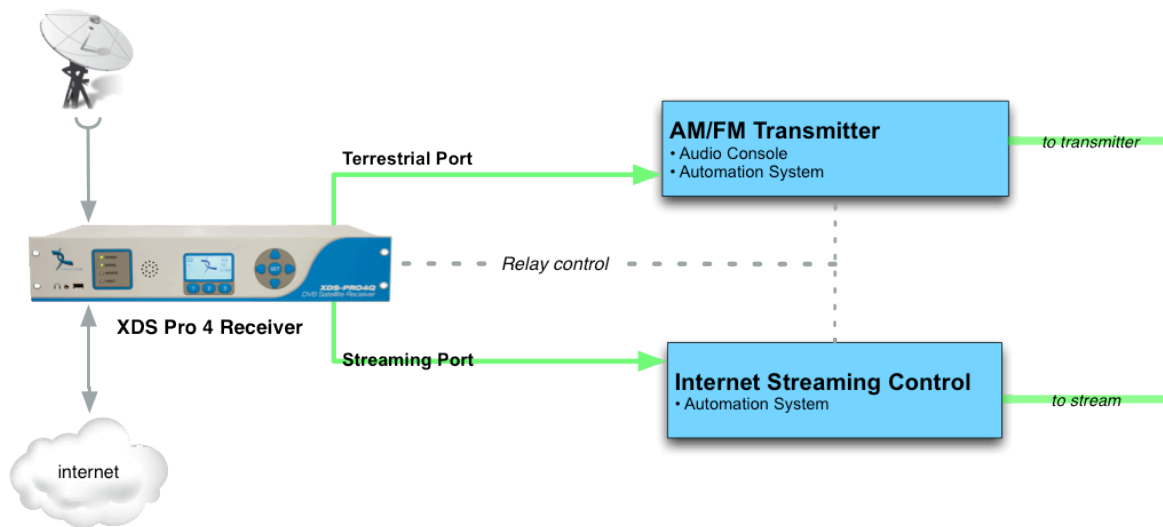


Attention Affiliate Partner:

Please review the following items regarding programming and scheduling your XDS Receiver:

Failure to comply by May 1, 2013 may result in DEAD AIR for your station.

ESPN Radio Network programming must come from your approved “-FM” or “-AM” site in XDS (ie. WEPN-FM or KSPN-AM). If the site call letters DO NOT match the station they are being used for, contact ESPN Radio Technical Support.



CONFIGURATION NOTES:

Terrestrial Port - Assigned Port must match call letters exactly*

Streaming Port: • For AM - port name ends in -AW • For FM - port name ends in -FW

Simulcasting - If simulcasting on two different radio stations, contact ESPN Radio Affiliate Technical Operations Center at espnradio3@espn.com

Stations cleared for internet web streaming must use the corresponding “-FW” or “-AW” internet streaming site in XDS (ie. WEPN-FW or KSPN-AW). If using any other site in your XDS receiver for internet streaming, contact ESPN Radio Technical Support immediately.

Scheduling for your XDS receiver must be done via <http://myxdsreceiver.espn.com>. If you have any questions on how to use the site, contact ESPN Radio Technical Support.

All Play-by-Play programming must be scheduled on a PER GAME basis though the Special Events section of the <http://myxdsreceiver.espn.com> site. Alternate programming (Program Re-Airs, Delayed Recordings, etc.) can be set up on each XDS Site. See our help website (<http://help.espnradio.com>) for alternate programming examples.

ESPN XDS Receivers must be connected to the internet. This is the only method we can provide full technical troubleshooting and backup during sun-fades or issues with dish equipment.
